HUBER Technology's products are principally used for the enhancement and protection of the environment. The Company is therefore well versed in the potential impact that such products will have on the environment whilst in use

HUBER Technology's products are used for solids/liquid separation of waste water and the end user is ultimately accountable for the disposal of the resulting waste fraction in an environmentally responsible fashion. In many instances the waste fraction is suitable for recycling or further re-use and HUBER Technology will typically work with customers to identify these opportunities

HUBER Technology are committed to good corporate citizenship, sustainable business practices and community support in an ethical and responsible manner. We are committed to reducing our global environmental impact such as climate control, through continuous improvement. The Company ensures that we integrate sustainability and climate control considerations into our business decisions.
